Sprint and Lure Coursing

You are invited to participate in sprint and lure coursing training and practice sessions conducted in the Upper Polo Field at the Bucks Mill Recreation Area in Colts Neck, NJ.

Whether your dog is a purebred, or mixed breed; an experienced racer or a complete novice—all are encouraged to attend.

By attending practices like this, your dog will be taught to chase a plastic bag (we don't use real bunnies!) and will run alone until their skills are such that they can course against one or two other dogs. All dogs are held and released at the start line by hand (no starting gates).

Even though these open practices are entry level, it's a great way to keep your dog fit. Dogs who run the course get a good workout. It's also a terrific opportunity for dog athletes training in other sports. It's a proven fact that cross-training is highly recommended for peak performance.

Friday/Saturday/Sunday* **Practices in Monmouth County**

Regular practices are held in the upper polo field at the Bucks Mill Recreation Area, off Bucks Mill Road in Colts Neck, NJ. To get to Bucks Mills, take Rte 537/Colts Neck Road (heading east from Freehold or west from Eatontown). Bucks Mill Road is directly across the street from the signpost for Hominy Hill Golf Course. Turn onto Bucks Mill Road and follow slowly about one mile. Make a left into Bucks Mills Recreation Area. Stay on the gravel road through the park. Follow the road as it turns left, past the pond and porta-potties, up a small hill. You'll see the practice field on your left.
